1. GENERAL

"Fund Raising Campaign" is an Event organised by Happy Elderly Services Limited for the purposes to raise fund for Happy Elderly Services Limited to support the expenditure of organising activities and providing services for the elderly people and its operation.

2. PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of accounting

The income and expenditure account has been prepared using the historical cost basis of accounting.

(b) Income recognition

Voluntary donation represents the donation received from the collection boxes for the period from 1 October 2011 to 30 November 2011.

3. TAXATION

As Happy Elderly Services Limited is registered as a charitable organisation under Section 88 of Inland Revenue Ordinance, the Event is exempted from Hong Kong profits tax.
